Crowd Funding Research

Wednesday 17 August, Wellington

When the first tranche of provisions of the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013 came into force on 1 April 2014, a new licensing regime for Crowdfunding Service Providers (CSPs) was introduced into New Zealand law – a regime that is one of most progressive and innovative operating in the world today.

The presentation will provide an overview of the nature of equity crowdfunding and how it implicates securities law. This will include an outline of the legal rules governing New Zealand's crowdfunding framework, the developments in the crowdfunding market place in the last two years, and the opportunities and threats to New Zealand's crowdfunding regime.

Trish is a senior lecturer in commercial law at the School of Accounting and Commercial Law at Victoria University of Wellington. Trish has presented for the New Zealand Law Society and currently contributes to LexisNexis's Morison's Financial Markets Conduct Act commentary. She also regularly presents at international conferences, has published in a number of New Zealand and international journals and is a co-author of 'Financial Markets Conduct Regulation" A Practitioner's Guide' published in 2014.
