New Zealand's economy is starting 2017 in decent shape. However, international developments, such as US President Donald Trump's potential policies, are creating uncertainty around New Zealand's good outlook.

Kim's presentation will include:

- the global picture and how events may influence New Zealand
- the key drivers of New Zealand's growth outlook
- the interest rate and NZ dollar outlook

**Kim Mundy, Economist at ASB Bank**



Kim focuses on the subjects that have the ability to impact most people daily - the housing market, mortgage interest rates and inflation. She forecasts, analyses and provides insight into what these topics mean to readers: the pros and cons for particular mortgage rate options, housing affordability, or how to prepare for inflation. Kim is the author for ASB's Home Loan Rate Report, Home Economics and Housing Confidence Survey.

Kim joined ASB in early 2015 after working as an Economic Consultant. She also interned with the New Zealand Treasury while completing her BA/BCom in Economics (1<sup>st</sup> class honours), Statistics and Politics.
