DEFINITIONS:

GRADUATE: Graduates of the Professional Education Programme who have successfully completed the academic requirements of applying for chartered membership. As long as graduates can demonstrate the relevant work experience to achieve chartered status, they can progress to Associate membership.

ASSOCIATE: Graduates of the Professional Education Programme who have gained the Chartered Secretary or Chartered Governance Professional qualifications.

FELLOW: Senior chartered members who have acquired a greater level of experience and responsibility within the profession.

AFFILIATED MEMBERS: Members who have studied three prescribed modules from the Professional Education Programme and are part-qualified but who do not want to seek either of the full chartered qualifications.

ICSI MEMBERS: Members of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India. An MoU operates between ICSI and ICSA to qualify ICSI Members.
